



Black Water Middle School Cell Phone/Electronic Device Policy

Rationale: Cell phones and/or electronic devices create distractions and disturbances to the learning process. Cell phones should be turned off and not visible or in use from 8:15 until your lunch period. When your lunch period is over, your cell phone should be powered off and out of sight until the end of the school day/3:30. Use of cell phones will be allowed during your lunch period only.

Headphones, Air Pods, and earbuds should not be worn on the head, neck or be visible during the school day-Exception is during your lunch period.

Students with an emergency and legitimate reason to use a phone during the school day should see an administrator.

The 1st violation will result in:

- 1. Cell phones/electronic devices that are visible or heard during the instructional day will be confiscated by any staff member.
- 2. A parent must pick up the cell phone/electronic device from the front office between 8:00 am and 8:30 am or between 4:00 pm and 4:30 pm.
- 3. The infraction will be documented in the student's discipline file.

There will be no exceptions to this rule. A parent must pick up the cell phone/electronic device from the front office between 8:00 am and 8:30 am or 4:00 pm and 4:30 pm.

** Cell phones should be turned off.**

The 2nd violation will result in:

- 1. The cell phone/electronic device will be confiscated.
- 2. A parent must pick up the cell phone/electronic device from the front office between the times of 8:00 am and 8:30 am or 4:00 pm and 4:30 pm.
- 3. The infraction will result in the assignment of one day of ISS along with documentation in the student's discipline file.

The 3rd infraction will result in:

- 1. The cell phone/electronic device will be confiscated.
- 2. A parent must pick up the cell phone/electronic device from the front office between the times of 8:00 am and 8:30 am or 4:00 pm and 4:30 pm.
- 3. The infraction will result in one day of OSS along with documentation in the student's discipline file.

Note: Refusal to obey any staff member who asks for a cell phone/electronic device will result in an additional disciplinary consequence to include an additional day of OSS.
