



Cell phones and electronic devices are prohibited during the school day. Electronic devices include, but are not limited to, smart watches, earbuds, gaming devices, etc. Students are required to power off and put away cell phones and electronic devices once the 8:05 a.m. bell rings, and students will not be able to utilize cell phones and electronic devices until 3:15 p.m. This means that students cannot use cell phones or electronic devices during lunches or transition.

Please see the updated consequences below. When confiscated, cell phones/electronic devices will be stored in the main office until the parent is able to retrieve it. A parent/guardian must pick up the cell phone/electronic device from the main office.

**The CHS Administration recommends that no items of value be brought to school.** If these devices are lost or stolen, the school will not be responsible for them.

Confiscated items will be returned to parent between 7:40 a.m.- 8:15 a.m. or 3:15 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. due to administrative duties.

4 <sup>th</sup> Offense	1 Day of OSS and Confiscation
5 <sup>th</sup> Offense	3 Days of OSS and Confiscation
6 <sup>th</sup> Offense	5 Days of OSS and Confiscation
7 <sup>th</sup> Offense	Evidentiary Hearing and Confiscation

If a student refuses to give up their cell phone or electronic device, the student will receive a referral for (270) Refusal to Obey and the following consequences will apply:

1 <sup>st</sup> Offense	1 Day of OSS
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense	1-3 Days of OSS
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense	3-5 Days of OSS
4 <sup>th</sup> Offense	Evidentiary Hearing
