

**2025 CMS Personal Device Policy
Cell Phone/Headphones/Smart Watches**

Specifics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cell phones, smart watches, and headphones must be powered OFF and in your bookbag for the entirety of the school day. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Phones CANNOT be in pocket or anywhere on your body or it will be a violation. ○ No smart watches on your wrist. ○ Absolutely no headphones or airpods. ● All violations will result in a disciplinary referral. ● All violations, including the warning, will result in the teacher taking the device, turning it into the front office, and a parent must pick it up. ● CMS is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged devices. ● NO cell phones at dismissal INSIDE the building (only when you exit) ● If you come in with no bookbag, you will need to turn in your phone to the front office and pick it up at the end of the day.
1st Violation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● Warning
2nd Violation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● 1 day of ISS
3rd Violation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● 2 Days of ISS
4th Violation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● 1 day of OSS
5th Violation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● 3 days of OSS
6th Violation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● 5 days of OSS
7th and beyond	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● Evidentiary Hearing
Refusal to give up phone to any adult	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Referral ● 1st Violation: 1 day of OSS ● 2nd Violation: 1-3 days of OSS ● 3rd Violation: 3-5 days of OSS ● 4th Violation: Evidentiary Hearing
