

Service Learning & Community Service Permission Slip

HCS Early College High School is a service learning and community service school. Students are required to complete 10 hours of service learning and 10 hours of community service for a total of 20 hours per year.

Students are asked to participate in activities designed to contribute to their respective communities and society. Participation in service learning and community service projects requires students to attend activities that occur after school hours and on weekends.

Early College High School staff will support and provide supervision for various service projects. Students who elect to participate are required to provide their own transportation to and from the event and adhere to applicable school rules and behavior guidelines set forth by Horry County Schools and by ECHS administration. Failure to comply with these rules can result in disciplinary action and loss of participation privileges in school supervised service activities.
