Parking Lot Rules and Regulations

ALL SCHOOL RULES SHALL APPLY IN VEHICLES AND PARKING LOTS

- 1. Observe speed limit on campus and traffic flow directions.
- 2. Respect and observe all directions of employee's parking/security personnel.
- 3. <u>Failure to abide by all school rules and parking guidelines will result in the loss of driving privileges and enforcement of discipline procedure.</u>
- 4. <u>Passing academic subjects is required to continue eligibility for parking/driving privileges</u>. If privileges are revoked, passing grades on the following report card will be required for driving/riding privileges to be reinstated.
- 5. <u>Student must be in good standing with the school or a parking tag will not be issued or may be revoked</u>. In good standing means no outstanding fines.
- 6. **NO PARKING** in the fire lanes, on curbs between spaces, **ALL** grass areas near or around **ANY** parking lots including: staff areas, tennis courts, ball fields, bus lot or behind the school building. **Fines will be accessed for violations which may include discipline actions or a parking ticket**.
- 7. No one is allowed in the parking lot for any reason without permission from an administrator. Bring all the items you need for the day when you leave the parking lot.
- 8. Students are to enter the building through the **FRONT** door immediately upon arriving on campus. Loitering in cars or the parking lots are not permitted.
- 9. Parking tag is to be affixed to the **left driver side bottom windshield**.
- 10. Do not switch tag to another vehicle for any reason.
- 11. If parking tag is suspended. There will be a \$5.00 reinstatement fee after suspension period.
- 12. CELL PHONES CAN'T BE USED WHILE DRIVING ON CAMPUS.

NO vehicle, except for those belonging to visitors for the day or approved volunteers, can be parked on school property without a current tag, for security reasons. Cars without tags are subject to be towed at owner's expense without prior notification.
