Cell Phone/Ear Buds Policy

MBHS allows the use cell phones and ear buds for non-academic use only before school, between classes, during lunch, and after dismissal.

During class devices should remain on silent and out of sight (unless permitted by the teacher for use on an assignment).

Recording is not permitted. Students caught recording altercations will be subject to suspension.

Administration has the authority to confiscate a cell phone and/or ear buds for parent pick up.

1st Offense- Minor Referral (Teacher Warning/Reteach Expectations)

2nd Offense- Minor Referral (Teacher Contacts Parent/Documents in PS)

3rd Offense- Office Referral (Lunch Detention 3 days)

4th Offense- Office Referral (Suspension Pending Parent Conference)

5th Offense- Office Referral (ISS 1 days)

6th Offense- Office Referral (ISS 3 days)

7th Offense- Office Referral (OSS 2 days)

8th Offense- Office Referral (OSS 3 Days)

9th Offense- Office Referral (Recommendation for Expulsion)

Students with a legitimate need to use a phone during the school day, such as emergencies, should see an administrator.

Refusal to comply with any administrator who asks for a cell phone/ electronic device or a teacher asks a student to put the phone away will result in OSS.

Parents/guardians may pick up cell phones between 3:30 – 4:00 PM. Cell phones will not be returned to persons other than the student's parent or legal guardian.

The school will not be liable for lost or damaged devices.
