

Cell Phone/Earbud Policy

During the school day, cell phones, earbuds, and similar electronic devices are required to be in silent mode and out of sight.

This includes; inside classrooms and in hallways during class and class changes.

To ensure safety, students are not permitted to walk around campus with:

- · Cell phones out and actively talking on the phone
- · Cell phones out and texting or using social media on the cell phones
- Earbuds in their ears whether using them or not
- Audio and video recording are not permitted and are subject to suspension.
 - Recording of any inappropriate behaviors on campus, including fighting, vaping, etc. will result in a minimum of 2 days OSS

Consequences

- 1st Offense Teacher Warning/Parents informed. Document in Log Entries
- 2nd Offense Referral to Administration Warning
- 3rd Offense Referral to Administration Lunch detention
- 4th Offense Referral to Administration— 1 block of ISS
- 5th Offense Referral to Administration— 1 day of ISS
- 6th Offense Referral to Administration 2 days of ISS
- 7th Offense 1 day of OSS
- 8th Offense 2 days of OSS/parent conference with administration

Referrals for cell phones/earbuds beyond the 8th offense will result in an evidentiary hearing for refusal to obey.
