## North Myrtle Beach High Tardy Policy

Students are expected to be in the classroom prior to the ringing of the tardy bell. Tardiness to class means a loss of instructional time for the tardy student and an interruption to the teaching and learning activities for the other students.

Students are expected to be in class on time. Students who are tardy shall be assigned ISS or OSS as stated below. In addition, students who drive to school shall lose their driving privilege if they exceed 4 tardies to school.

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Warning

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: Parent Contact

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: 1 Block of ISS/Parent Contact 4<sup>th</sup> Offense: 1 Day of ISS/Parent Contact 5<sup>th</sup> Offense: 1 Day of ISS/Parent Contact 6<sup>th</sup> Offense: 1 Day of OSS/Parent Contact 7<sup>th</sup> + Offense: OSS/Parent Conference

Searches will be conducted every morning beginning at 7:30 AM. Students are reminded to arrive on campus with enough time to allow for metal detectors.

Searches will not be considered as an excuse for being tardy to class.
