A student may be suspended from riding the school bus for misconduct following a disciplinary referral from the bus driver or bus supervisor generally using the following guidelines:

- 1st offense- warned 3 to 5 days lunch detention and /or may be suspended from the bus.
- 2nd offense- May be suspended from the bus 2 to 4 school days.
- 3rd offense- May be suspended from the bus 5 to 9 school days.
- 4th offense- May be suspended from the bus for up to 10 to 29 school days.
- 5th offense- May be suspended from the bus for 30 days or remainder of the school year.
- 6th offense- May be removed from the bus for the remainder of the year.

These guidelines may be adjusted based on the seriousness of the offense. If the bus supervisor and principal determine that the offense poses a direct and serious threat to the student or others on the bus, the student can be suspended from riding the bus for the remainder of the year.
