We are pleased to have your child on our teams this year. As their teachers, we believe that all children can behave appropriately in our classrooms. Rules are necessary to ensure a safe, positive learning environment. Please review the school rules and consequences outlined in your student's agenda. These rules apply at all times. Our first line of communication is the student's agenda. Please check the agenda daily for teacher praise and or concerns. In addition, the following class rules must be followed.

Rules:

1. Chiefs **RESPECT** not only themselves, but also fellow chiefs (students, teachers, adults), as well as personal and school property.
2. Chiefs **LISTEN** to and follow directions.
3. Chiefs make a **COMMITMENT** to giving their **BEST EFFORT** every day.
4. Chiefs are **PREPARED TO SUCCEED**.

Consequences:

- 1st Infraction- Verbal warning
- 2nd Infraction-Parent contact
- 3rd Infraction- Parent signature required on Teacher Lunch Detention
- 4th Infraction- Parent Conference required

*** Students will have a total of four interventions prior to receiving the following step, for any minor offenses (level two and level three offenses may result in immediate referral to administration).

- 5th Infraction- Office Referral

Rewards:

Students who follow school rules, exhibit good citizenship and act with responsibility are rewarded for their choices throughout the school year. Examples of such rewards are listed below:

- Verbal praise
- Class incentives
- May attend all assemblies, dances, and other fun activities for students with no discipline infractions.
