



Bus Behavior Form

At Ocean Drive Elementary we want every child to have a safe ride to and from school. In order to create a safe environment on the bus for students, behavioral expectations are spelled out in the Horry County Schools Parent/Student Handbook. Please review the expectations and consequences listed below with your student and sign this form. Your support and cooperation are needed and appreciated as we work together to transport your child safely to and from school.

While riding the bus...

- Go to your assigned seat without crowding or pushing.
- Remain seated while the bus is moving. (Back to Back, Bottom to Bottom, Book bag in your lap)
- Aisles and stairwells must be kept clear.

A student may be suspended from riding the school bus for misconduct following a disciplinary referral from the bus driver or bus supervisor generally using the following guidelines:

1st offense: Warning, review bus procedures with an administrator, and/or suspension from the bus

2nd offense: May be suspended from the bus for 1 - 4 school days.

3rd offense: May be suspended from the bus for 5 - 9 school days.

4th offense: May be suspended from the bus for up to 10 - 29 school days.

5th offense: May be suspended from the bus for 30 days or remainder of the school year.

6th offense: May be removed from the bus for the remainder of the year.

These guidelines may be adjusted based on the seriousness of the offense. If the bus supervisor and principal determine that the offense poses a direct and serious threat to the students or others on the bus, the student can be suspended from riding the bus for the remainder of the year.
